

Eligibility

Individual participant requirements are as specified in the FSAE Rules. In addition, all Formula Student competitors must be a member of IMechE. Team members may also be a member of other societies such as SAE or VDI but it is compulsory that all team members are an IMechE member. Affiliate membership is FREE:

Team Leaders need to ensure that all team members become IMechE members by 30 April 2010 as the process can take a while to complete due to all FS competitors requiring membership numbers. All membership numbers need to be quoted in the Team Members Details form. Faculty Advisors do not need to become members.

Medical insurance coverage for drivers, as referred to in section 4.7 of the FSAE Rules, is not necessary for EU Nationals competing in Formula Student.

Individual drivers are permitted to drive for more than one team, i.e. in Class 1 and Class 1A cars from the same university, but are only permitted to drive one car in any individual dynamic event.

All drivers must have a valid, current government issued car driver's license, or an approved karting or car motorsport license.

An individual university can enter a maximum of two running cars: Class 1 and Class 1(A). Two cars can be entered in the same Class, but the second car will only be eligible if places remain available when the registration period closes.

A joint entry by two institutions is allowed. Therefore, two universities or a university and a technical college can enter a class under the name of one of the institutions. There **MUST** be at least one Faculty Advisor responsible for supervising the joint project.

Teams wishing to bring their car to the following year's competition must not compete in any of the static or dynamic events for the competition that they are entered in.
